

Online Lesson Prep:**Zoom Application Download:**

- Please find the Zoom application download here: <https://zoom.us/download>
- Download the latest version and install.
- If you can, enable “Original Sound” in audio preferences. This tells Zoom not to cancel sound that is not a human voice, or that is too loud.

Preparation Checklist (Important):

- Isolate lesson area from potential noise (pets, open windows, running water, loud AC, etc.).
- Turn off ambient fans. (Fans cause sound distortion.)
- Position self facing a primary light-source with music stand to your left.
(This enables a view of the student’s bow technique.)
- Position camera securely (not on the music stand).
- Distance self from camera to enable consistent visibility above the waist. This should include both hands, elbows, head, and mid-body at all times.
- Adjust volume (higher) to hear guidance while you are playing. (This is usually a higher volume than anticipated.)
